Applicants may apply for registration <u>before</u> 1 January of the ATS year for which registration is sought. An application for registration will be processed within sixty days, unless further information is required.

Completing and submitting the application form

When completing and submitting this form follow any instructions provided in the ATS Application for Registration Guidelines.

Applicants wishing to access ATS must first fill in an application for registration form as a Motor Vehicle Producer (MVP), Automotive Component Producer (ACP), Automotive Machine Tool Producer (AMTP) or Automotive Service Provider (ASP). AusIndustry must approve an ATS application before the applicant becomes eligible to receive ATS assistance. Once registered under ATS, participants have an obligation to provide quarterly returns to claim assistance.

All values and figures should be recorded in full, as whole numbers. Do not use decimal points or round to the nearest thousand.

Privacy and confidentiality
