Environment Restoration Fund: 2019 grant opportunity - Sample Application questions

Please note when the program opens for applications you must complete and submit an online application on the business.gov.au portal. You will be provided with a link to the form.

This document provides a list of questions that we will ask you in the online application on the business.gov.au portal.

1. Eligibility

To be eligible your organisation must:

- be identified in Appendix A of the grant opportunity guidelines
- be invited to apply for a grant
- have an Australian Business Number (ABN).

You need to provide evidence from your board (or chief executive officer, general manager or equivalent if there is no board) that the project is supported, and that you can complete the project and meet the costs of the project not covered by grant funding.

To be eligible your project must:

- be consistent with the relevant project description provided in Appendix A of the grant opportunity guidelines
- be aligned to one or more of the intended program objectives
- include activities and expenditure consistent with the relevant project description
- support on-ground environmental restoration and protection across one of the three priority areas outlined in section 2 of the grant opportunity guidelines.

6. Assessment criteria

You must address all assessment criteria in your application. We will assess your application based on the weighting given to each assessment criterion.

We will only award funding to applications that score at least 50% against each assessment criterion, as these represent best value for money.

You are not required to provide a response up to the maximum character limit. The amount of detail and supporting evidence you provide should be commensurate with the project size, complexity and grant amount requested. You should define and quantify and provide evidence to support your answers.

Assessment criterion 1: Project alignment with program objectives (50 points)

(limited to 5000 characters, including spaces and paragraph returns).

You should demonstrate this by describing:

the extent that your project will support onground environmental restoration and protection projects across one or more of the three priority areas: protecting threatened and migratory species and their habitat; protecting Australia's coasts, oceans and waterways; and clean-up, recovery and recycling of waste.

Assessment criterion 2: Your capacity, capability and resources to deliver the project (30 points)

(limited to 5000 characters, including spaces and paragraph returns).

You should demonstrate this by describing:

- your track record in managing similar projects and your access to personnel with the right skills and experience including management and technical staff
- your plan to manage the project including scope, implementation methodology, timeframes, budget and project delivery risks
- your access, or future access, to any required land, infrastructure, capital equipment, technology, and regulatory or other approvals
- your capacity to manage the project sites where on-ground activity has occurred, after the life of this grant.

Assessment criterion 3: The impact of grant funding on your project (20 points)

(limited to 5000 characters, including spaces and paragraph returns).

You should demonstrate this by describing:

- the likelihood that the project would proceed without the grant and explain how the grant will benefit the size and timing of your project
- your justification for the funding amount requested with respect to the scale of the project and intended outcomes.
